## A RESOLUTION TO RATIFY THE UPDATE OF THE DISTRICT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee resolved to approve the updated solid waste management plan on February 25, 2022 and,

WHEREAS, it is our best judgment that the update will benefit the solid waste district by implementing required waste reduction programs, and

WHEREAS, public hearings were held in all four counties of the district to provide public input to the update and the Policy Committee has considered this input.

NOW **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Council of the Village of Kirkersville, County of Licking, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. The updated solid waste management plan as presented to the council shall be ratified for submittal to the Ohio EPA for their approval.
- SECTION 2. The clerk of this legislative authority is hereby authorized and directed to mail or otherwise deliver promptly a certified copy of this resolution to the Policy Committee.
- SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
- SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Kirkersville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village and for the further reason that this must be sent in within 90 days of receipt of notice. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
